

ECOLEAGUE eTwinning Project Ethical Guidelines



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1. RESPECT AND INCLUSION

- ALL PARTICIPANTS (STUDENTS, TEACHERS, PARENTS) MUST BE TREATED WITH RESPECT.
- DIFFERENT CULTURES, BELIEFS, AND OPINIONS SHOULD BE EMBRACED WITH TOLERANCE.
- EVERYONE HAS AN EQUAL RIGHT TO EXPRESS THEIR THOUGHTS, AND NO DISCRIMINATION IS ALLOWED.

2. DIGITAL SAFETY AND PRIVACY

- STUDENTS' PERSONAL INFORMATION (NAME, SURNAME, ADDRESS, ETC.) MUST NOT BE SHARED WITHOUT PERMISSION.
- PHOTOS OR VIDEOS IN WHICH STUDENTS' FACES ARE VISIBLE MUST NOT BE USED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
- SAFE INTERNET USAGE MUST BE ENSURED ON TWINSPACE AND OTHER DIGITAL PLATFORMS.

3. COPYRIGHT AND RESOURCE USAGE

- IMAGES, VIDEOS, AND TEXTS USED MUST COMPLY WITH COPYRIGHT LAWS.
- PROPER CITATION RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED.
- FOOTBALL TEAM LOGOS SHOULD ONLY BE USED FOR EDUCATIONAL AND AWARENESS PURPOSES, NOT FOR COMMERCIAL USE.

4. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY AND SUSTAINABILITY

- THE PROJECT SHOULD PROMOTE ENVIRONMENTAL **PROTECTION AND SUSTAINABILITY.**
- RECYCLING AND REUSING MATERIALS SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED.
- THE USE OF MATERIALS THAT MAY HARM NATURE SHOULD BE AVOIDED DURING THE PROJECT.



5. COLLABORATION AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION

- TASKS SHOULD BE EQUALLY DISTRIBUTED AMONG PARTNER SCHOOLS.
- ALL STUDENTS AND TEACHERS SHOULD ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN THE PROJECT.
- THE PROJECT SCHEDULE AND PLANNED ACTIVITIES SHOULD BE FOLLOWED.

7. COMMUNICATION AND PROBLEM-SOLVING

OPEN AND CONSTRUCTIVE COMMUNICATION
SHOULD BE MAINTAINED AMONG ALL

6. FAIR PLAY AND SPORTSMANSHIP

- SINCE THE PROJECT INVOLVES A FOOTBALL THEME, FAIR PLAY AND SPORTSMANSHIP SHOULD BE TAUGHT TO ALL STUDENTS.
- DISRESPECTFUL COMMENTS ABOUT OTHER TEAMS OR IDEAS SHOULD NOT BE MADE.
- HATE SPEECH AND HARMFUL MESSAGES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON ONLINE PLATFORMS.

STAKEHOLDERS.

- DISPUTES SHOULD BE RESOLVED IN A CIVILIZED AND RESPECTFUL MANNER.
- ANY ISSUES ENCOUNTERED DURING THE PROJECT SHOULD BE SHARED WITH COORDINATING TEACHERS.
- EEDBACK SHOULD BE GIVEN IN A SUPPORTIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE WAY.
- TEACHERS AND STUDENTS SHOULD REPORT ANY CONCERNS REGARDING INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR OR CONTENT.



8. RESPONSIBILITY IN PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ALL SUBMITTED WORK (VIDEOS, PRESENTATIONS, REPORTS) MUST BE ORIGINAL AND REFLECT THE EFFORTS OF STUDENTS AND TEACHERS.
- ANY DATA OR STATISTICS USED SHOULD BE ACCURATE AND PROPERLY SOURCED.
- PARTICIPANTS MUST RESPECT DEADLINES TO ENSURE SMOOTH PROJECT PROGRESS.
- SCHOOLS SHOULD ENSURE THAT PROJECT ACTIVITIES ALIGN WITH THEIR CURRICULUM AND EDUCATIONAL GOALS.
